Westgate Lodge offers quality care in a "home like" setting with common areas for use by residents and their family and friends. We are an accredited, 88 bed, Long-term Care Home, licenced by the Ministry of Health and Long-term Care.

We are located in a residential neighbourhood on the corner of Dundas Street West and Wilkie Street. Situated near a Marina, some rooms enjoy a view of the bay. Outdoor accessibility is offered in secured areas which are attractively landscaped. These areas have safety features built in to enhance the resident's time out of doors.

Our facility is staffed by Registered Nurses and other profession personnel on a 24-hour basis. An Advisory Physician is retained to oversee all matters relating to medical care. Whenever possible, residents are welcome to medical care provided by their physician of choice.

Westgate Lodge has an open door policy. Our professional and dedicated staff is available to address any question or concern you may have.

Attractive and nutritious meals and snacks are prepared daily in our kitchen, planned under the direction of a Licenced Dietician and our Food Service Supervisor.

Leisure Time

Residents can spend time with friends in the lounge, watch the large screen television or relax in one of the cozy, private areas available. Comfortable chairs and tables in the common areas provide a place for cards, games and conversations. A piano awaits a resident, entertainer or guest. Our Activity Director develops a monthly Activity Calendar of events with input from our residents. Family and friends are welcome to participate. Monthly resident council, and scheduled family council meetings ensure input and satisfaction for our residents and their families.

Special Care Unit

This 24 bed wing is especially designed to accommodate those residents with a dementia. The secured and safe environment caters to the individual characteristics of these residents. Outside of each resident’s room is a memory box containing their own pictures and memorabilia. This assists the residents in identifying the location of their room.
